RANGE RULES adopted January 2017:

- 1. Must have membership card in possession and be able to produce when asked. No guests.
- 2. No steel plates or explosive targets. Paper targets only. Must use Beartown backstops. Bullets traps are acceptable.
- 3. No shooting across ranges (i.e., rifle range to pistol range). No ground shooting.
- 4. Pistols only on pistol range.
- 5. Shooting hours 9:00 a.m. until dusk, 7 days per week. Third Sunday of the months September through May: range is closed for block shoots. Exception to shooting hours: club sanctioned events.
- 6. No alcohol.
- 7. Clays thrown right to left. Bird shot only.
- 8. No shooting beyond pavilion posts.
- 9. No steel core. No tracers. No incendiary. Lead core, range safe ammo only.
- 10. Limit 10 rounds on all firearms.
- 11. No automatic weapons. One shot per trigger pull.

Any member caught breaking the rules of Beartown Sportsman Association will have their membership card confiscated and must attend a meeting for discussion of continuation or revocation of membership.

As of January 1, 2021: A locked gate is installed on the Beartown Sportsman premises. A combination is required for entry. You will receive the combination **on your membership card** upon payment of membership dues.
